



## Sort, Roll and Go... The New Curbside Recycling Program

Pleasanton has joined Alameda County cities in adopting a number of new recycling programs, including meeting a countywide waste diversion target of 75% by 2010.

For the new residential curbside recycling program to be effective, residents are asked to actively participate by sorting recyclable material at home. Since all material placed in the trash cart will be landfilled, your participation in the recycling program is key. Fortunately, it's easy to keep all recyclable material out of the trash cart. Simply use the information below to identify those items that should be placed in the recycling container and develop the practice of regularly sorting your discarded material, including food scraps and yard waste. Remember, Sort, Roll and Go – It's Easy!



### Accepted Items for Recycling

- Paper
- Cardboard
- Aluminum containers and foil
- Steel or tin cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic bottles and tubs, such as yogurt, margarine and cottage cheese, numbers ♻️ through ♻️

### Non Accepted Items

- Waxed Paper Containers
- Plastic Bags
- Styrofoam
- Paper Towels & Napkins
- Food Soiled Paper & Cardboard
- Aerosol Cans
- Diapers


# Holiday Schedule

**PLEASE READ THE SCHEDULE CAREFULLY AS YOUR PICK-UP DAY MAY CHANGE DUE TO THE HOLIDAYS**

**Thanksgiving Day** There will be no interruption in garbage and greenwaste service for Thanksgiving Day. The Transfer Station, Recycling Center and main office will be closed Thursday, November 26.

**Christmas Day** Christmas Day falls on a Friday this year, therefore household collection service will be delayed by one day. In other words, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday pick-ups are on their scheduled day but **Friday pick-ups will be on Saturday**. The Transfer Station, Recycling Center and office will be closed Friday, December 25.

**New Years Day** New Year's Day also falls on a Friday this year, therefore, like Christmas week Friday's pick-ups will be delayed by one day. The Transfer Station, Recycling Center and office will also be closed Friday, January 1.



# Christmas Tree Recycling

**Christmas Tree Pickup** Pleasanton Garbage Service will pickup Christmas trees that are placed at the curb on Saturday, January 16th. Trees must be placed curbside the night before pickup and cut in four-foot sections. Please remove stands, tinsel, ornaments and lights. Pleasanton Garbage Service is not responsible for any decorations that are left on the tree. Or, if you would like to enjoy your tree for a bit longer you may place your Christmas tree cut in two foot sections inside your greenwaste container and it will be picked up on your regular pickup day. One stamp will be given for each 25 lbs. of recyclable material presented at the Buy Back Center. A total of 75 lbs. (3 stamps) of recyclable material must be presented during any given quarter to receive a credit. If you have an automated 96 gallon service, your quarterly credit will be \$3.51. If you have an automated 35 gallon service, your quarterly credit will be \$2.22.
