## Annual Audits & Route Reviews



Notice someone in a neon safety vest rummaging through your waste bins? It could be PGS staff conducting a required annual inspection of trash, recycling, and food/green waste.

SB 1383 requires that we annually inspect and audit a sample of residential carts and bins to ensure that residents are separating garbage, recycling, and food/green waste correctly.

During our 2026 Spring inspections we will evaluate containers for unacceptable items and leave a "Service" tag with information about what went wrong and needs corrective action.
